Daryl Hannah and the Osbournes in Tax Trouble

Actress Daryl Hannah, famed for her role as the mermaid in 'Splash' is in trouble with the IRS, as are rock star John (more popularly known as Ozzy) Osbourne and his wife, Sharon, co-hosts on 'The Talk' and judges in 'America's Got Talent'. Hannah has been issued a tax bill amounting to \$62,622. But this pales in comparison to the Osbournes' tax liability of more than \$1.7 million in back taxes.

Hannah's manager, Chuck Binder said, "I just made a deal for her. So whatever kind of things that are owed, if she does owe, will get cleaned up next week.

"The actress, now 50, is outspoken in her efforts to save the environment and is said to be worth \$15 million. She has been arrested twice in the past for her activism. In 2006, she chained herself to a tree in LA in protest of the bulldozing of an urban garden and again in 2009, she was arrested for helping to form a road block outside the Massey Energy Company coal plant to protest open top coal mining. Last year, Hannah said about her environmental activism, "As I get older I feel an increased sense of urgency about the global crisis. Each one of us has to reduce our impact on the

planet".

Hannah's recent acting roles include one in 'Garbage' with 'Kill Bill' co-star Michael Madsen and the 3-D horror comedy, 'El Dorado'.

Sharon Osbourne put the blame on their tax problems to poor bookkeeping, saying on Twitter, "You can't rely on anyone but yourself. You have to be on top of your business affairs. My fault...lesson learned".

The IRS has filed a lien on "the property and assets of John and Sharon Osbourne". The couple owe \$719,000 in unpaid taxes in 2008 and more than \$1 million in 2009. Sharon also had a lien filed against her in 2009 for \$23,000 she owed in taxes.

The Osbournes have put their 4,500 square-foot beachfront property that overlooks the Pacific Ocean on the market for \$10 million. The property was bought in 2003 for \$5.1 million and includes a library, office and hot tub.
