



California Car Accident Injures Twins

Six week old infant twins and their mother suffered minor injuries in a seven car pileup on Interstate 15 on Friday. Investigators are still investigating the cause of the **California car accident** that involved seven cars and at least five separate crashes, including three hit-and-runs. Firefighters responding to the California injury accident near West Bernardo Drive on southbound I-15. Two other victims were also taken to the hospital with various injuries.

Authorities are still investigating the cause of this **California accident**. Sometimes the CHP traffic collision report will help determine who was at fault based on witness statements and the physical evidence at the scene of the collision. However, further investigation, including accident reconstruction, is sometimes necessary to get to the bottom of which driver or drivers were entirely or partly at fault.

Some of the worst drivers are also the most irresponsible drivers. California law makes it a misdemeanor to leave the scene of a collision without stopping unless someone suffers serious bodily injury, in which case a "hit and run" becomes a felony. Despite these potential penalties, California Highway Patrol statistics indicate that 22,091 victims were injured in 2008 by irresponsible drivers who caused hit and run collisions.

Injured victims of car accidents always have to deal with a number of issues following each car crash. It is very important to find medical attention immediately. You always have to get documentation of your treatment and prognosis as soon as you can. Seek follow-up attention to eliminate the risk of subtle injuries that go unnoticed. Talk to your insurer as required, but

don't discuss potential accident causes. Consult with your lawyer first. Do not talk to any other insurance companies, and do not settle out of court without legal advice.
