APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Your application must include a curriculum vitae or résumé, and a personal statement that must address the following questions:

1. Why are you interested in becoming an Associate Editor?
2. How can you contribute to the OHLJ as an Associate Editor (include editing and research experience; relevant work and volunteer experience; technical, publishing, or computer experience; or any other relevant skills you may have acquired)?
3. Being on the Editorial Board of the OHLJ entails a high level of commitment. How do you plan to balance your classroom workload, personal commitments, and work at the OHLJ?

Your personal statement should be in paragraph form and no longer than two pages, double-spaced. Do not include transcripts, LSAT marks, or grades of any kind, as they will not be considered. We also ask that applicants remove any reference to marks in their CVs.

To be considered for the 2010–2011 Editorial Board, application materials must be submitted by 10 September, 2010 at 12 p.m. Late applications will not be considered.
