



3 Injured in Sacramento Bus Accident

Three people were hospitalized with [injuries after an accident](#) involving a Regional Transit bus two other vehicles. Although details are sketchy, police reports indicate that the bus rear ended a car stopped for a red light on Meadowview Road at the intersection with Tamoshanter Way. The impact may have pushed that vehicle into another vehicle stopped ahead. Two people riding in a teal sedan were taken to the hospital with injuries. One passenger of the bus was also taken to a hospital with a knee injury.

As common carriers, buses are held to a higher standard when it comes to providing safety during transportation. Although this Sacramento injury accident remains under investigation, initial reports indicate the bus driver was responsible for causing the collision. If so, the bus driver and his employer, a public entity, are legally responsible to each of the injury victims for their medical expenses, lost income and pain and suffering.

California Bus Accident Attorneys

In California, persons injured due to the negligence of an employee of a public entity must act quickly. California law requires that someone claiming damages against a public entity or its employee must file a claim for damages with that entity within six (6) months. Once the claim has been rejected by that entity, which is typical, the statute of limitations for filing a lawsuit can be as short as six (6) months from the date of rejection. Because these claims processes are complicated, it's a good idea to at least consult with a personal injury attorney with experience dealing with the governmental tort claims process.
