ORDER

THIS CAUSE came to be heard upon Defendants' Motion for Sanctions; and

IT APPEARING to the Court that for the reasons stated in the Court's Letter Opinion of November 8, 2010 that attorney, Due H. Tran violated Va. Code § 8.01-271.1 in the manner in which he prosecuted this litigation against the Defendants Vietnamese Medical Society of Northeast America, Inc., Vinh Duc Nguyen, Sang Van Tran, Loc Bich Nguyen, Anh Huu Pham and Truong Son Van (together as "Defendants"); it further

APPEARING to the Court for the reasons stated in the Court's Letter Opinion of November 8, 2010 that the appropriate sanction against Due H. Tran is the costs and reasonable attorney's fees of Defendants; it is therefore

ORDERED that Defendants' Motion for Sanctions is GRANTED; it is further

ORDERED that Due H. Tran shall pay the reasonable attorney's fees of Defendants incurred as a result of his sanctionable actions in the amount of \$7,500; it is further

ORDERED that Due H. Tran shall pay the costs of the Defendants' court reporter and transcripts incurred in the amount of \$730.75; it is further

ORDERED that Due H. Tran shall pay the total amount of \$ 8230.75 in attorney's fees and costs within thirty (30) days; it is further

ORDERED that the Court's Order of September 13, 2010 sustaining Defendants' demurrer and dismissing Plaintiff's Complaint without leave to amend and without prejudice is incorporated into this Order; it is further

ORDERED that the Court's Letter Opinion of November 8, 2010 and the Court's Order of November 19, 2010 denying Due H. Tran's Motion to Reconsider are incorporated into this Order; it is further

ORDERED that the Court's suspension of the Order of September 13, 2010 dismissing Plaintiff's Complaint is lifted.




