Any judgment in first degree may be appealed before higher court (excepting few cases).

Recourse to Cassazione (Supreme Court of Cassazione) may be applicable after negative second degree judgment, but only on the ground of incorrect application of law by second degree court.

In any case, second degree judgment could be appealed before same court, via "revocation", which requires:

- Bad faith of one of the parties
- False testimony
- New evidences
- Error in fact, evidenced by documents.
