ORDER

THIS MATTER CAME BEFORE THE COURT this day, upon Plaintiff's Motions to Compel Discovery Responses of Defendant Virginia Hospital Center. Based upon supplementation of VHC the issues regarding **Interrogatories 3, 6,10,15,16,** and **Document Requests 35 and 36** are withdrawn.

This ORDER reflects both the Court rulings as well as memorializes the Agreements reached between the Parties.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that on or before June 3, 2011 the following shall be produced:

1. Defendant VHC shall provide a further response to **Interrogatory 1** to include the identity, employer and contact information of each health care provider who attended Mrs. Kipoliongo at VHC on July 10, 2008 from 12:30 a.m. to 9:30 a.m.


2. Defendant VHC shall provide a further response to Interrogatory 4 to identify all additional health care providers in the VHC records and shall describe the substance of their knowledge.
3. Defendant VHC shall provide a full and complete answer to Interrogatory 7 in accordance with Judge Brodie's ruling.
4. *Plaintiffs' motion to compel VHC's answer to*
~~Defendant VHC's answer to Interrogatory 14 is subsumed within the response~~
~~ordered to Request for Documents 37 and 39 as set forth below.~~ *denied.*
5. Defendant VHC shall provide an answer to Interrogatory 17 setting forth the total number of patients in the labor and delivery ward for the period of 12:30 a.m. through 7:00 a.m.
6. Defendant VHC shall provide an answer to Interrogatory 18 setting forth the number of labor and delivery nurses working in the labor and delivery ward for the period of 12:30 a.m. through 7:00 a.m.
7. The Court denied the necessity of further response to Interrogatory 19.
8. Pursuant to Document Requests 37 and 39, defendant VHC shall provide the OB TraceVue Audit Trail(s) for all labor and deliver patient entries made by Nurse Bates Gilpin for the period 12:30 a.m. to 7:00 a.m. on July 10, 2008. Such entries shall be redacted to remove the identifying characteristics such as patient name, medical record number (MRN), race and newborn ID to protect patient confidentiality.


