

Former Justice Weaver censured

According to an article in today's *Detroit Free Press*, the Michigan Supreme Court "has issued a pointed and public rebuke of a former justice, Elizabeth Weaver, for making secret recordings of internal court deliberations and releasing some of the transcripts." The *Free Press* reports that the censure is in the form of a letter signed by Chief Justice Marilyn Kelly and Justices Cavanagh, Corrigan, Markman, and Young.
