The Supreme Court has [granted review](#) in two civil cases:

- *Aryeh v. Canon Business Solutions, Inc.*, [S184929](#), in which the Court will address the application of the continuing violation doctrine, the continuous accrual doctrine, and the delayed discovery rule to actions brought under the Unfair Competition Law ([Bus. & Prof. Code, § 17200 et seq.](#)).
