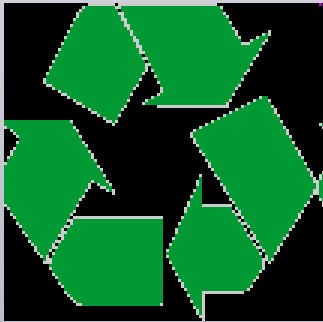

# *Why Else?*

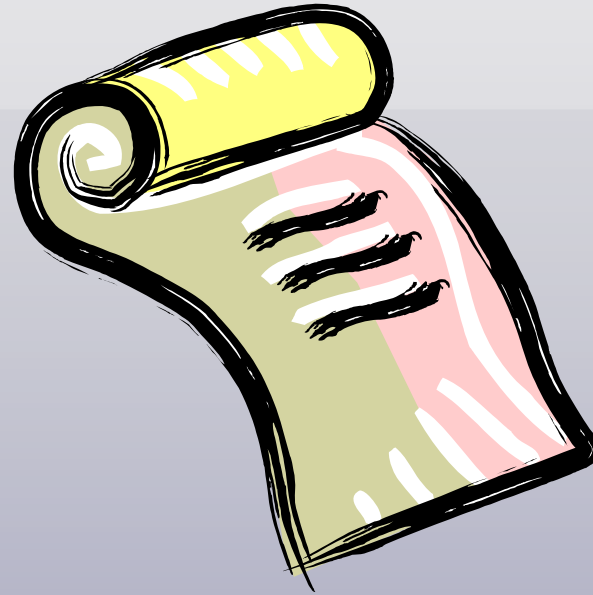
