New Canadian Experience Class

As of August 12th 2008, Citizenship and Immigration Canada has put into effect the new **Canadian Experience Class**; thus, making it much easier for international graduates and/or temporary workers to attain **permanent residency**. Those that apply under this new category enjoy **priority processing of their applications**. This is just another way in which the Government of Canada is helping Employers attain the best and brightest international professionals in a more timely and efficient manner.

A summary of how the program works follows:

Students

International students who graduate from at least a two-year program at an approved post-secondary institution and who have one year of Canadian work experience may apply for Permanent Residency under the CE class while they are in Canada.

Work experience must be at Skill Type O (managerial occupations) or Skill Levels A (professional occupations) or B (technical occupations and skilled trades) on the Canadian National Occupations Classification.

Temporary Workers

International Professionals that are in Canada with temporary worker status for a minimum of two (2) years may apply for Permanent Residency under the CE class.

The work experience must be at Skill Type O (managerial occupations) or Skill Levels A (professional occupations) or B (technical occupations and skilled trades) on the Canadian National Occupations Classification.
