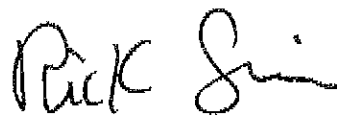
UNREPORTED MINUTE ORDER

UNREPORTED MINUTE ORDER

In the event that respondent files such points and authorities, petitioner shall have 10 days thereafter to file and serve a responsive Memorandum of Points and Authorities.
