STIPULATION OF DISMISSAL OF DEFENDANT DENISE “DEDE” DREXLER


TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

Plaintiffs N. Del Rio and Victor Del Rio have decided it is in their best interests not to pursue their claims in this lawsuit against Defendant Denise “Dede” Drexler any longer.¹ Pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(a)(1)(ii), all parties to this lawsuit who have appeared (which to date is only the Plaintiffs and Defendant Drexler) stipulate to the dismissal of Defendant Drexler from this action, including all claims asserted by the Plaintiffs against Defendant Drexler. The undersigned counsel of record is authorized by his client to sign this Stipulation of Dismissal on behalf of his client. This dismissal shall have no effect on the Plaintiffs’ claims against any Defendants in this matter other than Defendant Drexler.

Cause for suit is the ongoing denial of an IDEA 2004 genuinely compliant education six years to date including abuse defined by TFC § 261.001 that form the basis of a 'protocol' that destroys my son's, incl. mine as a result, life. As of this date, I've not seen nor would I ever approve this 'protocol' from previous discussions with C.G. & J.H. at B&G and SISD. As of this date, I've not seen nor heard from my son despite 311th Family Court hearings and want to prosecute Tracey Del Rio and Attorney E. Pagel who are in full support of and enforcing this 'protocol'.
