In our law the general rule is clear, not written, that you can not use the legal instruments provided by law for a lawful reason other than that for which the instrument was designed, and to obtain the benefits that the legislation did not intend to offer or even prohibit.

In every field of law must be used according to the principles of good faith and protect the trust.

Any other use constitutes an abuse of it by the legislature must be fought not only with specific rules in areas where it is easy to predict where it can hide, but also by those institutionally must comply with the written and unwritten rules of our legal system, in gaps left by the legislature.
