## "In all criminal prosecutions, the accused shall enjoy the right to a speedy and public trial, by an impartial jury of the State and district wherein the crime shall have been committed, which district shall have been previously ascertained by law, and to be informed of the nature and cause of the accusation; to be confronted with the witnesses against him; to have compulsory process for obtaining witnesses in his favor, and to have the Assistance of Counsel for his defence."

Many claim to be "patriots" and respect the Constitution yet it appears they only want enforced those passages to which they agree. Due process is a nuisance (Casey Anthony, O.J. Simpson) unless they support the defendant (George Zimmerman). Like it or not, EVERYBODY deserves zealous representation.

Criminal defense is not about helping people get away with crime. It's about making sure that the rights granted in the Constitution are protected wholeheartedly. Making sure that criminal defendants get every protection that you and I are also guaranteed. Making sure the State meets their burden of proof before anyone loses their precious freedom.
