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### **JUDGMENTS**

#### Commonwealth

12 November 2014 - Hunter and New England Local Health District v McKenna; Hunter and New England Local Health District v Simon [2014] HCA 44

Mr Pettigrove was involuntarily admitted to hospital under the *Mental Health Act* (NSW). Following psychiatric assessment, Pettigrove was discharged into his friend's (Mr Rose) custody. While Rose was transporting Pettigrove from the hospital to his mother's care, Pettigrove killed Rose.

Rose's relatives brought claims in the District Court of NSW for psychiatric injury allegedly suffered as a result of Rose's death. They claimed that the hospital and the doctor who assessed Pettigrove owed Rose and his relatives a duty of care to exercise reasonable professional care and skill, and that they breached this duty by discharging Pettigrove into Rose's custody.

The trial judge found that the hospital owed Rose and his relatives a duty of care, although this duty was not breached. The relatives succeeded on appeal to the Court of Appeal. The Health Authority then appealed to the High Court of Australia.

In determining whether the hospital owed Rose and his relatives a duty of care, the High Court noted inconsistencies between common law and the *Mental Health Act*. There is a common law duty on hospitals discharging mentally ill patients to give regard to the interests of those who might come into contact with that person when not detained. Conversely, the Act requires a mentally ill person to be released unless the medical superintendent of the hospital forms the opinion that no other less restrictive care is appropriate and reasonably available.

As a result of this inconsistency, the High Court held that the duty under the *Mental Health Act* prevailed - the hospital did not owe Rose or his relatives a duty of care.
