INTRODUCTION

ELECTION 2020

A deeply divided country has thus far failed to produce clear results for the 2020 national election, dubbed by many as the most consequential in a generation. Counting the record number of votes cast in key battleground states like Pennsylvania, Michigan, Wisconsin, and Georgia will determine if President Donald Trump is reelected or former Vice President Joe Biden is elected the 46th president.

Control of Congress also remains in doubt. Democrats will continue to run the House, although the Republicans will likely pick up a few seats. The outcome in the Senate remains unsettled, but the Republicans appear to a have a more direct path to retain their majority status than the Democrats have to flip Senate control.

As of 8:00 am this morning, the Democrats have a net pick-up of one Senate seat after defeating incumbents in Arizona and Colorado, but losing a seat in Alabama. They need two more pick-ups to win control in the Senate, assuming Biden is elected resident and incoming Vice President Harris breaks a 50-50 tie. Five Senate races are too close to call, in which Republican Senate incumbents in North Carolina, Maine, Georgia, and Alaska are ahead while a Democratic incumbent in Michigan is surprisingly behind. The Democrats would need to hold Michigan and beat two of the four Senate incumbents to gain control. There will also be at least one run-off in Georgia on 5 January, which could ultimately decide the outcome for the Senate.

The Election Guide lists all new members elected to Congress, updates the congressional delegations for each state, and provides a starting point for analyzing the coming changes to the House and Senate committees.

- Complete delegations for each state are included with new Members of the House and Senate highlighted in yellow to indicate no change in party and their predecessors shown. Seats that switched parties are highlighted in red for Republican pick-ups and blue for Democratic pick-ups. Races that are too close to call are highlighted in gray.
- Roster lists for each full Committee from the departing 116th Congress are included, with non-returning members lined out. The full Committee House and Senate Chairmen and Ranking Members noted reflect the 116th Congress, <u>not</u> necessarily what to expect for the 117th Congress. We will continue to update the Committee information as Chairmen and Ranking Members are selected and the rosters are finalized for the new Congress.
