that it is considering updates to its implementing regulations under the National Environmental Policy Act. The Advance Notice of Proposed Rulemaking seeks public comment on whether CEQ's NEPA regulations should be revised to ensure better interagency cooperation and concurrent, more efficient multi-agency reviews. In responding to the ANPR, it will be important for commenters to think carefully about how CEQ can streamline the NEPA process in a manner that is consistent with other legal requirements.
