One such law is the Worker's Compensation Act which protects both part time and full time employees who become injured. Both private and public sector employers are subject to these laws, and as such carry these types of benefits for their employees. There are many types of injuries for which workers in Wisconsin are entitled to compensation by their employers. Injuries that cause both physical and mental harm may be covered, including injuries such as bruises, burns, and fractures. If you contracted an occupational disease like dermatitis, infection, tuberculosis, pneumonia, lead poisoning, or a respiratory disease, you may also be eligible to receive worker's compensation benefits. To find out if your particular injury is covered, speak with a knowledgeable worker's comp attorney in Wisconsin Rapids.

Depending on the severity of your injury you may be entitled to benefits that cover all your damages. Key benefits may include temporary total disability, permanent partial disability, physical therapy, medical tests, prescription medications doctor's visits, and hospitalization.
