FTC Sues Data Broker for Selling Data from Reproductive Clinics and Places of Worship

In a complaint filed this week, the Federal Trade Commission (FTC) alleges that a data broker sold geolocation data from individuals showing their movements to and from sensitive locations, including reproductive health clinics, places of worship, and substance use disorder clinics. Kochava, the broker in question, allegedly collects and sells GPS location data from consumers via their mobile devices. *Read more*

NYC Law Restricting Use of Al in Hiring Takes Effect in January: Are You Ready?

Last year, the New York City Council passed Local Law Int. No. 1894-A, which amended the City's administrative code to afford new protections to employees during the hiring and promotion processes. The law protects those individuals from unlawful bias by the employer when automated employment decision tools are used. Employers must conduct Al tool audits to confirm that such tools are not biased. The results of those audits must be published on publicly- available websites. Furthermore, the employer is required to disclose the data that the Al tool collects either by disclosing it publicly or in a response to an inquiry. *Read more*
