ORDER

This matter coming to be heard on Plaintiff's Motion for a Mandatory Temporary Restraining Order. Thus, the Court

finds:

- ① The preservation of the liquor license is a protectable interest
- ② Plaintiff will suffer irreparable harm if the liquor license renewal application is not executed by Andrews on or before 4/1/15.
- ③ There is no adequate remedy at law available.
- ④ There is a fair question as to Gerald's right to relief for her claim of breach of fiduciary duty.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: Julie Andrews must execute WCA's liquor license renewal application prior to the April 1, 2015 deadline.
