Economic Measures	<ul style="list-style-type: none">The Central Bank of the UAE has withdrawn AED 34.15 billion out of excess liquidity in the market during the first five months of 2020 after it met the market needs for cash during the period. (Link)
Health & Safety	<ul style="list-style-type: none">On June 29, the UAE saw 437 new cases (+6.58% from the previous day) of the coronavirus, bringing the total to 47,797 total confirmed cases. (Link)The Abu Dhabi Department of Health has confirmed that all Al Dhafra Hospitals are completely free of coronavirus cases. (Link)Sheikh Khalifa Specialty Hospital in Ras Al Khaimah has no patients with confirmed coronavirus cases. (Link)
