

Last Will and Testament
of
Edward Allen Richardson

I, Edward Allen Richardson residing at 2110 Blake Ave, City of Lester Prairie, County of McLoed, State of Minnesota, being of sound and disposing mind and memory, and not acting under undue influence of any person whomsoever, make, publish, and declare this document to be my last will and testament, and expressly revoke all prior wills and codicils, made by me.

Article I

I direct my personal representative hereinafter named, to pay all my legally enforceable debts, and expenses of my last illness, funeral, burial, and estate administration out of the residue of my estate. I further direct my personal representative to pay out of my residuary estate all estate, income, and inheritance taxes assessed against my taxable estate or the recipients thereof, whether passing by this will or by other means, without contribution or reimbursement from any person.

Article II

I have intentionally not provided in this will for my son, Mark Richardson, and this omission is not caused by accident or mistake.

Article III

I want to give my 2005 Chevrolet Corvette, which I own, to my brother Matthew Richardson, if he survives me.

Article IV

I give the rest and remainder of my estate, real, personal, or mixed, of whatever kind and wherever located, after the payment of debts, expenses, and taxes as mentioned in Article I, to my wife, Claudia Louise Richardson, if she survives me. If she does not survive me, I give said residue to my children, Elizabeth Richardson, Mary Richardson, and Donald Richardson in equal shares.

Article V

I wish to have any and all grandchildren inherit from their parent under per stirpes.

Article VI

In event the my wife, Claudia Louise Richardson could not act as guardian of Elizabeth Richardson until she is of legal age I nominate and appoint Donald Richardson to be her guardian.

Article VII

I nominate and appoint my wife, Claudia Louise Richardson, to be executrix of this will and to serve without bond. As well as Donald Richardson to be the successor executor if Claudia is unable to act.

Article VIII
