## Medicare Administrative Contractor Awards Protested

Protests have been lodged regarding four of the five Medicare Administrative Contractor (MAC) awards that the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) announced on January 7, 2009. See "CMS Announces Final Five Medicare MACs" (Payment Matters, January 23, 2009) for a discussion of CMS's awarding of the MAC contracts.

The protests concern contracts that CMS awarded to the following companies for administration of Medicare Part A and B claims payment:

- Noridian Administrative Services, LLC Jurisdiction 6 (Illinois, Minnesota and Wisconsin);
- National Government Services, Inc Jurisdiction 8 (Indiana and Michigan);
- Palmetto Government Benefits Administrators, LLC Jurisdiction 11 (North Carolina, South Carolina, Virginia and West Virginia); and
- Highmark Medicare Services Jurisdiction 15 (Kentucky and Ohio)

These newest protests recall the response to CMS's naming of recovery audit contractors (RACs) last year. See "RAC Program Resumes" (*Payment Matters*, February 19, 2009). The General Accounting Office is reviewing the protests and must render its decision as to each protest by May 2009.
