The petition of Chad Sanderson respectfully alleges:

1. The Town of Seneca Falls, New York (the "Town") is a municipal corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the Laws of the State of New York.
2. The petitioner, at all of the times hereinafter mentioned was and now is an elector of the Town duly qualified to vote upon a proposition to raise and expend money. The petitioner, at all of the times hereinafter mentioned was and now is a duly qualified voter of the State of New York, County of Seneca and Town of Seneca Falls and a duly enrolled voter of the Republican Party.

3. The petitioner resides at property known as 2891 State Route 89, Seneca Falls, New York, Town of Seneca Falls, County of Seneca and State of New York. The petitioner is the owner of certain other real property located within the Town of Seneca Falls, County of Seneca, State of New York New York.

4. On the 18 day of March, 2014 the Town Board duly adopted a certain resolution entitled "RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF SENECA FALLS TO EXPEND FUNDS FROM THE TOWN FACILITIES CAPITAL RESERVE FUND OF THE TOWN OF SENECA FALLS, SUBJECT TO PERMISSIVE REFERENDUM," dated and adopted March 18, 2014 (Exhibit 1).

5. On the 15 day of April, 2014, a petition was filed with the Nicaletta Greer, Seneca Falls Town Clerk, protesting against the aforesaid Resolution and requesting that the same be submitted to the qualified electors of said Town for their approval or disapproval. The petition identifies on its cover sheet, pursuant to 9 NYCRR 6215.8 and/or other applicable authority, the following Contact Person[s] to correct deficiencies: Joyce Brady, 7 Jay Street, Seneca Falls, NY 13149, 315-568-8119 or Sue Sauvageau, 61 ½ Fall Street, Seneca Falls, NY 13148, 315-569-2426. A true copy of said petition is annexed hereto and made a part hereof (Exhibit 2).

6. Within five days after the filing of the aforesaid petition, and on the 18 day of April, 2014, the petitioner duly filed a written objection thereto with the Town Clerk. A copy of said written objection is annexed hereto and made a part hereof (Exhibit 3)

7. The aforesaid petition is insufficient, void and not in accordance with the provisions of the Town Law of the State of New York and the Election Law of the State of New York in that: *[specification of grounds of objection(s)]*

- a. Invalidation of all of the 350 purported signatures, set forth on pages 1-23 of the petition, inclusive, and the petition itself and in its entirety, on the basis that the preamble of the petition fails to require each signatory/voter to state that his or her "present place of residence is truly stated opposite [his or her] signature." *See, e.g., Town Law § 91; Election law § 6-140(1)(a); Kurtz v Town of Amherst, 244 AD2d 895 (4 Dept. 1997); Fisher v Sampson, 27 AD3d 560 (2006).*
- b. Invalidation of all of the 350 purported signatures, set forth on pages 1-23 of the petition, inclusive, and the petition itself and in its entirety, on the basis that the preamble of the petition lacks any affirmative articulation of the objections upon which the Petition is founded, thus providing no notice of the specific basis upon which the petition is based. *In re Mount Pleasant, 82 Misc2d 869 (1975); Mathewson v Town of Kent, 41 Misc3d 572 (2013).*
- c. Invalidation of all of the 350 purported signatures, set forth on pages 1-23 of the petition, inclusive, and the petition itself and in its entirety, on the basis that the signatures to each sheet are not authenticated in the manner provided by the

election law for the authentication of nominating petitions. *Town Law § 91*. Pursuant to *Election Law § 6-132[2]*:

There shall be appended at the bottom of each sheet a signed statement of a witness who is a duly qualified voter of the state and an enrolled voter of the same political party as the voters qualified to sign the petition, and who is also a resident of the political subdivision in which the office or position is to be voted for. However, in the case of a petition for election to the party position of member of the county committee, residence in the same county shall be sufficient. Such a statement shall be accepted for all purposes as the equivalent of an affidavit, and if it contains a material false statement, shall subject the person signing it to the same penalties as if he or she had been duly sworn. The form of such statement shall be substantially as follows:

STATEMENT OF WITNESS

I, (name of witness) state: I am a duly qualified voter of the State of New York and am an enrolled voter of the party. I now reside at (residence address).

Each of the individuals whose names are subscribed to this petition sheet containing (fill in number) signatures, subscribed the same in my presence on the dates above indicated and identified himself or herself to be the individual who signed this sheet.

I understand that this statement will be accepted for all purposes as the equivalent of an affidavit and, if it contains a material false statement, shall subject me to the same penalties as if I had been duly sworn.

Witness identification information: The following information must be completed prior to filing with the board of elections in order for this petition sheet to be valid.

Each and every page of the petition set forth on pages 1-23, inclusive, and the signatures thereon, is/are not properly authenticated in the above manner for the following reasons:

- i. The witness statement at the bottom of each page of the petition does not state that the witness is a duly qualified voter of the state.
- ii. The witness statement at the bottom of each page of the petition does not state that the witness is an enrolled voter of any political party.
- iii. The witness statement at the bottom of each page of the petition does not

state that each of the individuals whose names are subscribed to the petition sheet identified himself or herself to be the individual who signed that sheet.

- iv. The witness statement at the bottom of each page of the petition does not state or affirm that the witness understands that, if the witness statement “contains a material false statement, [it] shall subject me to the same penalties as if I had been duly sworn.” *Longo v Mitloff*, 51 AD2d 1052 (2d Dept. 1976), *aff’d* 38 NY2d 1018.
 - v. The witness statement at the bottom of each page of the petition does not contain the “witness identification information,” to wit, Town or City and County, completed and below the signature of the witness.
- d. Invalidation of all of the 350 purported signatures, set forth on pages 1-23 of the petition, inclusive, and the petition itself and in its entirety, on the basis that the petition is insufficient in that it does not indicate each signatory’s election district as required by Election Law. *Graham v City Clerk of City of Ogdensburg*, 104 AD2d 703 (3d Dept. 1984); *Matter of Lindley v Babylon Town Clerk*, 80 AD2d 879 (2d Dept. 1981), *aff’d* 53 NY2d 683; *Mathewson v Town of Kent*, 972 NYS2d 428 (2013).
- i. Upon information and belief, the Town of Seneca Falls is divided into eight (8) election districts pursuant to Election Law § 4-100(3)(b) as follows:

The signatories’ respective election districts are not indicated in the petition as required by sections 6–130 (1) and 6–132 (1) of the Election Law. The signatories list only “Seneca Falls” and their (presumed) street addresses. The petition, as designed and circulated, does not contain a


box, blank or other area for signatories to set forth their election district on any of the pages 1-23, inclusive.

8. No previous application for the relief sought herein has been made to any court or judge.







THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF SENECA FALLS, duly convened in a regular session, does hereby resolve pursuant to the provisions of section 6-c of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York that the Town Supervisor of the Town be and he hereby is authorized and directed to transfer from the Town Facilities Capital Reserve Fund Of The Town Of Seneca Falls, duly established on November, 4, 2009, to the Annual Budget for the year 2014 and 2015, \$2,555,814.60, of the principal and accumulated interest in said Reserve Fund, to be used to construct a new Town Hall facility during the 2014 and 2015 fiscal year.

THE TOWN BOARD FURTHER RESOLVES that pursuant to Section 90 of the Town Law that within ten (10) days from the date of this resolution the Town Clerk shall post and publish a notice which shall set forth the date of the adoption of the resolution, shall contain an abstract of such resolution concisely setting forth the purpose and effect thereof, shall specify that this resolution was adopted subject to a permissive referendum; and shall publish such notice in the Reveille, a newspaper published in Seneca County having general circulation in the Town of Seneca Falls, and in addition thereto that the Town Clerk shall post or cause to be posted on the sign-board of the Town of Seneca Falls, a copy of such notice within ten (10) days after the date of the adoption of this resolution.

This resolution shall be subject to a permissive referendum, as permitted by law.

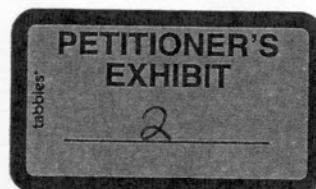

The undersigned alleges that said petition is insufficient, void and not in accordance with the provisions of the Town Law of the State of New York and the Election Law of the State of New York.

SPECIFICATION OF OBJECTIONS:

- a. Invalidation of all of the 350 purported signatures, set forth on pages 1-23 of the petition, inclusive, and the petition itself and in its entirety, on the basis that the preamble of the petition fails to require each signatory/voter to state that his or her “present place of residence is truly stated opposite [his or her] signature.” See, e.g., *Town Law § 91*; *Election law § 6-140(1)(a)*; *Kurtz v. Town of Amherst*, 244 AD2d 895 (4 Dept. 1997); *Fisher v. Sampson*, 27 AD3d 560 (2006).
- b. Invalidation of all of the 350 purported signatures, set forth on pages 1-23 of the petition, inclusive, and the petition itself and in its entirety, on the basis that the preamble of the



petition lacks any affirmative articulation of the objections upon which the Petition is founded, thus providing no notice of the specific basis upon which the petition is based. *In re Mount Pleasant*, 82 Misc.2d 869 (Sup. Ct. 1975); *Mathewson v Town of Kent*, 41 Misc 3d 572 (Sup Ct 2013).

- c. Invalidation of all of the 350 purported signatures, set forth on pages 1-23 of the petition, inclusive, and the petition itself and in its entirety, on the basis that the signatures to each sheet are not authenticated in the manner provided by the election law for the authentication of nominating petitions. *Town Law § 91*. Pursuant to *Election Law § 6-132[2]*:

There shall be appended at the bottom of each sheet a signed statement of a witness who is a duly qualified voter of the state and an enrolled voter of the same political party as the voters qualified to sign the petition, and who is also a resident of the political subdivision in which the office or position is to be voted for. However, in the case of a petition for election to the party position of member of the county committee, residence in the same county shall be sufficient.  - iii. The witness statement at the bottom of each page of the petition does not state that each of the individuals whose names are subscribed to the petition sheet identified himself or herself to be the individual who signed that sheet.
 - iv. The witness statement at the bottom of each page of the petition does not state or affirm that the witness understands that, if the witness statement “contains a material false statement, [it] shall subject me to the same penalties as if I had been duly sworn.” *Longo v. Mitloff*, 51 AD2d 1052 (2 Dept. 1976), *aff’d* 38 NY2d 1018.
 - v. The witness statement at the bottom of each page of the petition does not contain the “witness identification information,” to wit, Town or City and County, completed and below the signature of the witness.
- d. Invalidation of all of the 350 purported signatures, set forth on pages 1-23 of the petition, inclusive, and the petition itself and in its entirety, on the basis that the petition is insufficient in that it does not indicate each signatory’s election district as required by Election Law. *Graham v City Clerk of City of Ogdensburg*, 104 AD2d 703 (3d Dept. 1984); *Matter of Lindley v. Babylon Town Clerk*, 80 AD2d 879 (2d Dept. 1981), *aff’d*. 53 NY2d 683; *Mathewson v. Town of Kent*, 972 NYS2d 428 (Sup 2013).
- i. Upon information and belief, the Town of Seneca Falls is divided into eight (8) election districts pursuant to Election Law § 4-100(3)(b) as follows:



signatories list only "Seneca Falls" and their (presumed) street addresses. The petition, as designed and circulated, does not contain a box, blank or other area for signatories to set forth their election district on any of the pages 1-23, inclusive.

A verified petition setting forth the objections of the undersigned to said petition will be duly presented to the Supreme Court, State of New York, as authorized by law.




