Kentucky is The Latest State to Adopt the NAIC Insurance Data Security Model Law

Kentucky Governor Andy Beshear recently signed <u>House Bill 474</u> to become the latest state to enact data insurance security legislation. The new law is modeled after the data security law of the National Association of Insurance Commissioners (NAIC). Licensees with more than 50 employees who are authorized to operate, or are registered under the insurance laws of Kentucky, must comply with the new law. The law requires that licensees comply with data security provisions such as developing a written information security program, investigating and reporting cybersecurity events to the insurance commissioner within three days, and conducting risk assessments. *Read more*
