This action came on regularly for trial on April 22, 2005, in Department 70 of the Superior Court, the Honorable Jay Bloom, Judge presiding; the plaintiff appearing bv attorney James J. Filicia and the defendant appearing by attorney Kenneth W. Drake of Rushfeldt, Shelley & Drake, LLP. A jury of 12 persons was regularly impaneled and sworn. Witnesses were sworn and testified. Answer "yes" or "no". Answer: YES. If you answer Question 1 YES, then answer Question 2. If you answer Question 1 NO, go to Question 3. Ouestion No. 2: Was the negligence of Defendant Joel Berger, D.D.S., M.D. more likely that not a cause of harm to Plaintiff Giarrusso? Answer "yes" or "no".

Answer: YES. Proceed to Ouestion 3. Question No. 3: Did Debra Giarrusso give informed consent to the Ramus Bone Graft? Answer "yes" or "no". Answer: YES. If you answered NO, go to Question 4. If you answered YES, move on to Question 5, only if you previously answered Question 2 YES. If you answered Question 3 YES and Question 1 or 2 NO, stop here, answer no further questions, and have the presiding juror sign and date this form. Ouestion No. 4: Would a reasonable person in Debra Giarrrusso's position have consented to a Ramus Bone Graft if she had been fully informed of the possible risks of the Ramus Bone Graft? Answer "yes" or "no". Answer: If you answered NO to Question 4, then go to Question 5. If you answered Question 4 YES, move on to Question 5 only if you previously answered Question 2 YES. If you answered Question 4 YES and Question 1 or 2 NO, stop here, answer no further questions, and have the presiding juror sign and date this form. Question 5: What are Ms. Giarrusso's damages? a. Past economic loss for medical \$ 3,093.00 expenses: b. Future economic loss, for medical \$ 6,000.00 expenses: c. Past noneconomic loss, for physical pain, physical impairment and emotional suffering. \$100,000.00 d. Future noneconomic loss, for physical pain, physical impairment and emotional suffering: \$ 50,000.00 TOTAL \$159,093.00 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED:
