

Bicyclist Injured In a Sacramento Accident

A 17-year-old bicyclist was injured in a Sacramento accident this morning. As reported, a female bicyclist was travelling westbound in the 1600 block of Vallejo Way near **California Middle School** when she ran into a parked car's door that was unexpectedly opened. The victim was then struck by a passing car. The girl was transported to the local hospital.

The Sacramento accident remains under investigation. Witness accounts are important, but there may be other information that can ultimately influence who will be deemed responsible, in whole or in part, for a collision. If the driver of a vehicle injures a bike rider while violating a Vehicle Code section, or while failing to use due care while driving, he or she can be held civilly liable for monetary damages in the amount of all medical expenses, lost income and pain and suffering. If the driver of the vehicle is also working at the time, the employer can also be held liable for the damages. In most cases, it is vital to conduct investigation immediately so evidence is not lost due to the passage of time.
