SEC Adopts New Cybersecurity Rules for Public Companies

In a 3-2 vote, the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) adopted new cybersecurity rules yesterday (July 26, 2023) applicable to public companies.

The rules, which will become effective thirty days after publication in the Federal Register, require public companies to "disclose material cybersecurity incidents they experience and to disclose on an annual basis material information regarding their cybersecurity risk management, strategy, and governance." <u>Read more</u>

# California Privacy Protection Agency Announces CCPA Enforcement Focus

A plan for an enforcement program under the California Consumer Privacy Act (CCPA)/California Privacy Rights Act (CPRA) (collectively CCPA) is on its way from the California Privacy Protection Agency (CPPA). Despite a <u>recent court ruling</u> that the enforcement of some of the amendments under the CPRA cannot begin until March 2024, last week the CPPA revealed three key areas of its enforcement focus. While the CPPA is still in the process of building and hiring the enforcement team, the agency indicated that despite the court ruling it will still begin enforcing the underlying statute and previous regulations this year. <u>*Read more*</u>
