On order of the Chief Justice, the Court granted two motions for the temporary admission to practice law in Michigan, granted the defendant-appellant's motion to extend the deadline for filing it's brief and granting leave to file a brief in excess of 50 pages in [People v. Trakhtenberg](#), permitted the defendant-appellant to file a second supplemental brief in [People v. Rao](#), and granted the Attorney General's motion to participate in oral argument in the matter of [People v. Vaughn](#). At oral argument, the Court will permit the Attorney General to use eight minutes of the time allotted to the plaintiff-appellant.

The Court also granted a number of motions to file briefs amicus curiae. The Michigan Bankers Association and the Michigan Credit Union League are permitted to file briefs in [Estate of Darryl Price](#) and the ALCU Fund of Michigan may file an amicus brief in [People v. Cole](#). The Court also granted the motion of the Coalition for Protecting Auto No-Fault to file a brief amicus curiae in [Admire v. Auto-Owners](#). Finally, the Michigan Association for Justice's motion to file a brief amicus curiae in [McCahan v. Brennan](#) was granted.
