Welcome to the March edition of the Alston & Bird CPSC Recall Snapshot.

The CPSC has been very aggressive over the past month. This past Friday, the Commission announced a record \$15.45 million civil penalty against a Chinese manufacturer and its U.S. sales division for failure to timely report alleged defects with a humidifier. The penalty was the maximum allowed under the CPSIA and is nearly \$10 million more than the next-highest civil penalty ever issued by the Commission. In addition to announcing a record civil penalty, the CPSC took unprecedented action on hoverboards. Specifically, the CPSC issued an open letter announcing that it may take regulatory action against hoverboards that do not meet recently developed UL requirements. The CPSC stated that noncompliant boards *may* be subject to seizure and that the CPSC *may* seek recalls of any sold in the U.S. Many have criticized this action as an improper attempt to circumvent the mandatory procedural requirements for rule making, including a requirement that the agency provide notice of proposed rules and collect and consider public comments before promulgating the rule. We will continue to monitor the CPSC's actions on hoverboards and provide updates in future *Snapshots*.
