Sony headquarters earns LEED Gold

Bloomberg - Apr 22

Sony Electronics headquarters in San Diego earned LEED Gold and features (1) 47% recycled materials in construction, (2) 47% water savings below code using low flow fixtures, and (3) 5% of building energy supplied by rooftop solar panels.

AT&T -- First ballpark to earn LEED Silver

MLB - Apr 21

The San Francisco Giant's AT&T Park is the first major league park to earn LEED-EB Silver. It features enhanced building systems; Energy Star-rated flat panel monitors throughout the park; low-flush fixtures; re-commissioning of all mechanical systems; and water conservation measures.

Starbucks opens LEED building in Manhattan

A 15-year-old Starbucks store in Manhattan received LEED certification with features that include wooden wall panels made from reclaimed wood brought in from Pennsylvania and community message boards made of old coffee machine stands.

Enermodal earns first ever LEED BD+C Platinum

USGBC - Apr 22

Enermodal Engineering, specializing in sustainable and energy-efficient building solutions, earned LEED Platinum for its Denver office. The office is the first in the world to be certified under the new LEED 2009 BD+C (Building Design and Construction) rating system.

Intel earns first LEED Gold building in Israel

Intel - Apr 22

Intel Corp. earned LEED Gold for its Intel Design Center 9, set to open in Haifa, Israel, in June. It is the first building in Israel to receive this level of LEED certification. It features an Intel Xeon processor-based data center that significantly reduces power consumption, with expected annual savings of \$200,000; an automatic control system that regulates the flow of natural light; a rooftop garden; and a heating system that heats the building with dissipated heat from the air conditioners and data center computers.

The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints showed off its new green meetinghouse in Farmington, Utah, one of five models being constructed according to the LEED green building prototypes. Further, the Holy Wisdom Monastery of the Benedictine Women of Madison, Wisconsin, earned LEED Platinum certification for green elements that include a geothermal heating and cooling system.
