Rose to Take Waldrop's Seat on 3rd Court

The Governor's Office has <u>announced the appointment of Judge Jeff Rose</u> (pictured) to fill the vacancy created by <u>former Justice Alan Waldrop's resignation</u> from the Third Court of Appeals. Last week, Judge Rose lost a bid to remain on Travis County's 353rd District Court, a bench to which Governor Perry appointed him following Judge Scott Ozmun's untimely death.

Earlier this week, Governor Perry <u>appointed former Harris County District Judge</u>

<u>Harvey Brown</u> to fill a vacancy on Houston's First Court of Appeals. Brown had been in private practice at Wright, Brown & Close.

Justices Rose and Brown will each have to run in the 2012 general election to retain their new seats.
