As part of the financial reform legislation, Congress passed a new whistleblower statute that allows for a whistle-blower who provides "original information" leading to the successful prosecution of the violation of securities laws to recover anywhere from 10% to 30% of the total monetary sactions when the sanctions exceed one million dollars. (http://tinyurl.com/2cf2a8y) Congress has established an "Investor Protection Fund" to pay whistleblowers and fund investigations.
