Using a Cell Phone While Stopped at a Red Light??

California restricts the use of cell phones while driving. Apparently, under a recent case (*People v. Nelson* filed November 14, 2011, First District, Div. Two Cite as 2011 S.O.S. 6098) using a cell while stopped at a traffic light also violates Vehicle Code Sec. 23123, which states that persons shall not drive on public roadways using a wireless telephone unless the phone is configured for hands-free listening and talking, and used in that manner while driving.
