## **Proposition 37 Advisory IV**

NOVEMBER 7, 2012

On November 6, 2012, a majority (53%) of California's citizens voted against Proposition 37, which would have required the labeling of certain genetically engineered foods and prohibited the use of words such as "natural" on the label of certain processed foods. The Proposition received support of voters in the state's coastal metropolitan areas but failed to gain the support of inland voters.

We had previously reported on the ballot intiative in <u>Advisory I</u>, <u>Advisory II</u>, and <u>Advisory II</u>, and Proposition 37 prompted a lively legal and scientific debate throughout the country on the subject of food labeling in general and genetically engineered labeling in particular. For the present, however, there will be no mandatory labeling of genetically engineered foods in California.
