26	to solicit or entice Former Employer's clients or prospects on behalf of New Employer
27	utilizing trade secret or confidential information that I acquired through my employment

Other than the details provided in this declaration, I did not "take" any of Former Employer's confidential business information and I certainly did not take any Former Employer's confidential business information with me when I resigned my employment. In fact, the only Former Employer information that I can think of that I have in my possession from Former Employer are copies of expense reports that I submitted for reimbursement during my employment with Former Employer. Accordingly, I have not "used" any confidential business information from Former Employer since prior to my resignation and then I was using the information only to perform my job duties on behalf of Former Employer.
- 16. The home computer on which I performed work for Former Employer is a family computer. I have personal tax returns on that computer and [my spouse uses the computer to do work for his/her clients.]
