

## Proposed FMLA Regulations on Military Family Leave and Flight Crew Eligibility Published in Federal Register; We Need Your Feedback

Late last month, I reported that the Department of Labor had announced <u>proposed changes</u> to the Family and Medical Leave Act regulations with respect to Military Family Leave, Flight Crew FMLA Eligibility and the manner in which employers calculate increments of FMLA leave.

This morning, these proposed regulatory changes were published in the <u>Federal Register</u> (pdf), which means that the public has 60 days, or until April 16, 2012, to comment on them.

We strongly encourage you to make your voice heard about these proposed regulations.
