## SECTION I.

In the county of Seneca, the provisions of Section 3 of the Public Officers Law of the State of New York requiring a person to be a resident of the political subdivision or municipal corporation of the state for which such person shall be chosen or within which such person's official functions are required to be exercised, shall not prevent a person from holding the office of correction officer in Seneca county, provided, however, that such person performing the duties and functions of correction officer resides in Seneca county or any adjoining county within New York state, unless otherwise provided by an act of the state legislature.

## SECTION II. Effective Date.

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the secretary of state in accordance with Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
