

Fatal Sacramento Bicycle Accident

A 22-year-old student, Arlene Sasse died after she was hit by white Hyundai on Friday.

The fatal accident happened outside the main entrance to the campus at 1:45 a.m. The bicyclist was headed south on Carlson Drive and the driver was headed east on J Street when the accident happened.. It does not appear that the driver was speeding and the alcohol. The Sacramento accident remains under investigation. The bicyclists are much more exposed than occupants of a vehicle and much more likely to sustain serious injury or death in an accident. According to the California Highway Patrol, 11,390 bicyclists were in injured in accidents in California in 2008. The cause of the Elk Grove collision remains under investigation.

Witness accounts are important, but there may be other information that can ultimately influence who will be deemed responsible, in whole or in part, for a collision. If the driver of a vehicle injures a bike rider while violating a Vehicle Code section or while failing to use due care while driving, he or she can be held civilly liable for monetary damages. If the driver of the vehicle is also working at the time, the employer can also be held liable for the damages. In most cases, it is vital to conduct investigation immediately so evidence is not lost due to the passage of time.

Nothing is more devastating than losing a loved one, especially if it is unexpected and as the result of someone's negligence. The law provides that certain family members, usually a spouse, child or parent, have the right to recover compensation for certain losses if someone

is liable for causing another person's death. These losses include both economic and non-economic damages. The most significant economic loss recoverable in a wrongful death claim is typically the loss of financial support and other benefits that the deceased would have provided in his or her lifetime to the person making the claim. Non-economic damages include the loss of love, support and companionship of the deceased person.
