On July 20, 2011, the Michigan Supreme Court denied 13 applications for leave to appeal, including the application in *Ulrich v Farm Bureau Ins*, No. 141190, which was previously held in abeyance pending the decision in *Idalski v Schwedt*, No. 141190. Justices Cavanagh, Marilyn Kelly, and Hathaway would grant leave to appeal.

The Michigan Supreme Court remanded People v Hill, No. 142253, to the Court of Appeals for consideration as on leave granted.

The Court ordered that the application in *People v Grant*, No. 142378, be held in abeyance pending the decisions in *People v Likine*, No. 141154, *People v Parks*, No 141181, and *People v Harris*, No 141513, currently pending on appeal before the Court.

The application for leave to appeal in *People v Franklin*, No. 141062, remains pending. The Michigan Supreme Court directed the Saginaw County Prosecuting Attorney to answer the application within 28 days after the date of the order, "addressing the issues whether the trial court failed to comply with MCL 767.61a when accepting defendant's pleas to the charge of being a sexually delinquent person, and whether defendant's convictions are barred by double jeopardy."
