

## Sacramento Hit-and-Run Accident Injures Bicyclist

A bicyclist suffered major injuries in a Sacramento hit-and-run accident on Thursday morning. He was hit by a black Mercedes Bradshaw near Micron Avenue. The biker was thrown off his bike and the driver of the Mercedes left the scene. The victim was taken immediately to the hospital. The Sacramento-hit-and-run accident remains under investigation. The police report indicates driver of the Mercedes may have been speeding.

California law requires that a driver that has been involved in a collision to stop and provide his or her license and insurance information, regardless of the level of seriousness or extent of injury. Failing to do so can result in criminal charges including a felony hit & run charge when a victim sustains serious bodily injury. CHP statistics indicate that 22,091 safe drivers were injured in 2008 by irresponsible drivers who caused hit and run collision.
