Units: About 19,000

Importer: Claire's Boutiques Inc., of Hoffman Estates, III.

**Manufacturer:** Dae Yeon Industries Corp., of China**Hazard:** The heart lock charms attached to the bracelets contain high levels of cadmium. Cadmium is toxic if ingested by children and can cause adverse health effects.

Incidents/Injuries: None reported.
