## **Proposed State Health Plan Adjustments**

A. PA2019-002, Vitality Senior Living Management, LLC, d/b/a Traditions of Athens, LLC: Proposes to add 32 specialty care assisted living facility beds pursuant to Section 410-2-4-.04(2)(e) of the 2014-2017 Alabama State Health Plan to be converted from existing assisted living facility beds in Limestone County. Opposition: None.

Approved.

B. PA2019-003, Phoenix Senior Living, d/b/a The Bluffs at Greystone: Proposes to add 32 specialty care assisted living beds pursuant to Section 410-2-4-.04(2)(e) of the 2014-2017 Alabama State Health Plan to provide for a multi-level senior living community that will provide a continuum of senior housing options on a contiguous campus under the same ownership and management in Shelby County, Alabama. Opposition: ALI-Danberry Lessee, LLC d/b/a Danberry of Inverness and Memory Care at Somerby at St. Vincent's One Nineteen.

Approved, as amended, to add 32 specialty care assisted living beds pursuant to Section 410-2-4-.04(2)(e) of the 2014-2017 Alabama State Health Plan in Shelby County, Alabama.

C. PA2019-004, Monroe County Health Care Authority, d/b/a Monroe County Hospital: Propose to add 10 geriatric psychiatric inpatient beds pursuant to Section 410-2-4-.10(4) of the 2014-2017 Alabama State Health Plan to be converted from 10 general acute beds in Monroe County. Opposition: None.

Approved.

D. PA2019-006, Legendary Living Services VR, LLC: Proposes to add 24 specialty care assisted living facility beds pursuant to Section 410-2-4-.04(2)(e) of the 2014-2017 Alabama State Health Plan for location at a senior living community providing a full continuum of services to include cottage living, independent living, assisted living, and specialty care assisted living services on a single contiguous campus in Montgomery County. Opposition: None.

Approved.

**E. PA2019-007, EAMC-Lanier:** Proposes to add 20 geriatric inpatient psychiatric beds in Chambers County, Alabama, pursuant to Section 410-2-4-.10(4) of the *2014-2017 Alabama State Health Plan* to enhance and expand the availability and accessibility of care critical to the well-being of the 65 and older population suffering with dementia and other psychotic diseases. **Opposition: None.**
