- Does the attorney make you feel comfortable?
- Do you feel like the attorney really listens to you and answers your questions?
- Is the lawyer upfront about the legal services to be provided and the fee you will be charged?
- Will the attorney handle your matter personally, or will his staff do the majority of the work?
- Do you feel like the attorney is thorough in learning about you and your finances?

The above list is just a sample of questions you will want to consider asking the lawyers you interview. It is important that you do not feel pressured to make a decision during your initial consultation. Take time to consider all of your options. At the end of the day, you need to follow your gut instinct.
