## Brain damaged boy's family accepts \$8.5M malpractice settlement

The family of a severely brain-damaged child in Bayonne, New Jersey will be paid \$8.5 million to settle a medical malpractice lawsuit brought against the former owners of the Bayonne Medical Center and three medical workers. Attorneys representing the former owners of the hospital and the family settled the multimillion-dollar lawsuit after five days of testimony.

hospital at 1:30 a.m. on Aug. 14, 2005 with labor pangs. All prenatal tests pointed to a

normal healthy baby. But at 9:32 a.m., the heart monitor attached to her abdomen

showed the baby's heart suddenly plunged from 140 beats per minute to the

dangerously low level of 60 beats per minute.

Phone records show that the labor and delivery room nurse waited almost half an hour

before calling the attending obstetrician and when he arrived from Staten Island 22

minutes later, he waited until 10:55 a.m. to start an emergency C-section.

The reason for the baby's low heart rate was that his umbilical chord was compressed

and the fetus was starved for oxygen. The delays, therefore, left Jose Ordonez, now 5,

with permanent brain damage and needing full-time care. The boy is prone to seizures,

cannot see, walk, or hold his head up by himself, and he must be fed through a straw.

Besides the hospital, the parents sued the obstetrician, the delivery room nurse, and

her supervisor.
