1	On August 21, 2015, the parties to State of California v. Iipay Nation of Santa		
2	Ysabel, et al. (Case No. 3:14-cv-02724-AJB-NLS) ("State Case") and United State		
3	of America v. Iipay Nation of Santa Ysabel, et al. (Case No. 3:14-cv-02855-AJB-		
4	NLS) ("United States Case") filed a Rule 26(f) Report and Joint Case Managemen		
5	Statement (ECF No. 31). On August 31, 2015, the Order Granting Joint Motion T		
6	Consolidate was entered. (ECF No. 32.)		
7	The Court now ORDERS that the following scheduling shall apply to the

9	1. <u>United States Response to Counterclaim</u> : The United States will respond
