Many medical and union organizations opposed the legislation as well. Clearly, there are forces at work to bring forward legislation that will change workers' compensation in Illinois. While this author believes the Agreed Bill Process is the best forum for Labor and Management to negotiate, the State legislators may very well take matters into their own hands again in the spring session.
