Because contemnor was acting as attorney for a party at the time of the contempt order, s/he was acting as an officer of the court, and is entitled to release on personal recognizance and a separate contempt hearing before a different judge than the one who entered the initial contempt finding, per Section 21.002(d) of the Government Code.

WHEREFORE, contemnor requests the court to:

1. Release contemnor on his/her own recognizance;
2. Request the presiding judge of the administrative judicial region to assign a judge to determine contemnor's guilt or innocence of the alleged contempt; and
3. Issue a show cause order specifically setting forth the charges against contemnor, and giving reasonable notice of the time and place of any hearing on the alleged contempt.
