Welcome to the October edition of the Alston & Bird CPSC Recall Snapshot.

Effective October 1, 2019, Commissioner Bob Adler became the acting chairman of the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission. He was elected by majority vote of his fellow commissioners to replace Ann Marie Buerkle, who announced in June that she would be stepping down as acting chairwoman. She continued to serve as a CPSC commissioner until October 27, 2019.

Some say the election of Adler, a Democrat, is a surprise, given that the commission was made up of a 3–2 Republican majority at the time of the vote. Buerkle, a Republican, voted for Adler, stating that she believed the "most experienced, most senior commissioner" should be the one to serve in the role. The other Republican commissioners, Peter Feldman and Dana Baiocco, both joined the CPSC in 2018. Elliot Kaye (D) has served as a commissioner since 2014, and Adler has served since 2009. Buerkle's departure from the CPSC altogether means the commission will return to a 2–2 split along party lines. This occurs barely one year after the Republicans gained a majority on the CPSC for the first time since 2006.
